

MOONTA MINES HERITAGE WALKING TRAIL 3



Time and Difficulty

Time: 45 minutes (return)

Distance: 2.41km

Attractions and Facilities

Supported by the National Trust SA, this is one of 3 trails to leave from and return to the Moonta Mines Museum. Situated on the former Moonta Mines Primary School (1878), the museum is an interpretive centre for Moonta history and Cornish copper mining period.

***Be careful of wildlife and uneven terrain, and take care while crossing roads and railway lines. Do not remove materials from this heritage area or disturb structures, and do not climb on or over fences. If you notice damage to signs or other vandalism while walking, please report it to the National Trust or District Council of the Copper Coast.*

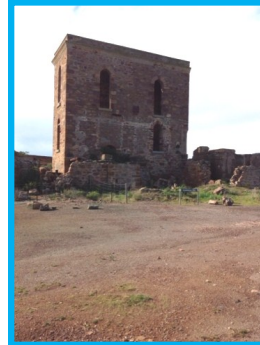
